



Fees for Programs

Try-its & Badges: \$48.00 for up to 15 scouts. No charge for parents, siblings and leaders

Sleepovers: \$185.00 for up to 15 scouts. \$9.00 each additional girl. Chaperones free. *

Campfire programs: \$75.00 for up to 18 participants. \$4.00 each additional person.

*Must have 1 adult chaperone for every 4 girls.

Making Reservations

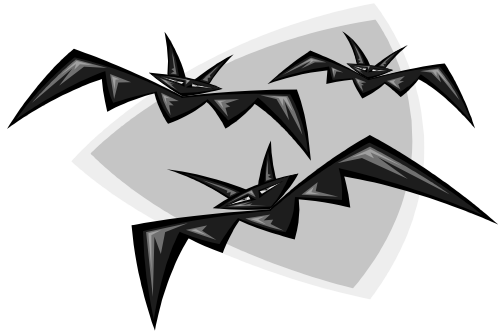

- ✦ Star Party

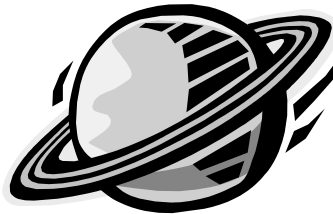
The 1-1/2 hour program will include a 1-hr. night hike and a campfire with marshmallows. You may bring your own beverage.
