Churchville Nature Center is happy to announce our exciting and fun **sleepover program**. This program is designed to give scouts an indoor camping experience while they earn a badge of their choice. An experienced educator will work with the scouts on a 1 ½ hr. nature or Lenape program geared towards earning their badge. The evening will include a storytelling campfire with marshmallows and a sleepover in the auditorium. This will help make their camping trip a memorable one. After breakfast and clean up the next morning, they can visit the gift shop and leave, or if there are any programs that day, they can stay for them. (We ask you to bring your own sleeping bag and pad, breakfast and snacks – we will provide the marshmallows)

Minimum fee: \$185.00 for 15 Scouts - \$9.00 for each additional scout, with a maximum of 36 scouts. Must have 1 adult chaperone for every 4 scouts.
