Perennials

Achillea millefolium 'Terra Cotta' (Yarrow) ☼βχϝ☺

COLOR: Yellow Orange HEIGHT: 2'
BLOOM: Late Summer SOIL: Tolerant of dry, poor soil. Excellent drainage is a must
COMMENTS: This unique yarrow displays a multicolored effect, emerging with bright peach flowers that slowly change into a clay pot color, hence the name. Pronounced silver foliage.

Agastache 'Black Adder' (Hyssop) ☼β⋈χϝ

COLOR: Blue Violet HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: Late Summer SOIL: Well drained
COMMENTS: 'Black Adder' boasts numerous bottlebrush flowers of vivid blue from mid summer to frost on a compact, rounded plant.

Agastache 'Blue Fortune' (Hyssop) ☼β⋈χϝ

COLOR: Purple HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: July-September SOIL: Average to dry soil
COMMENTS: Strong stalks shoot upward in spring with fuzzy licorice-scented leaves. In summer, the stems are topped with hundreds of bottlebrush flowers that attract a array of pollinators!

Amsonia tabernaemontana -variety salicifolia (Blue Star) ☼○βϝ

COLOR: Light Blue HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: Late Spring/Early Summer SOIL: Wet
COMMENTS: Long-lived, clump-forming, herbaceous perennial features 3-4 weeks of light blue, star-shaped flowers in spring. Followed by ornamental seed pods. Easy to grow and no-fuss.

Aquilegia canadensis (Wild Columbine) ☼○☺⋈ϝ

COLOR: Red spurs, yellow sepals HEIGHT: 18"
BLOOM: April - June SOIL: Moist, well-drained soil
COMMENTS: Great and consistent performance.

Aruncus dioicus (Goat's Beard, or Bride's Feathers) ☼☼○❖⌘β

COLOR: White HEIGHT: 3-5'
BLOOM: May, June SOIL: Moist, wet
COMMENTS: Showy, finger-like flower clusters, which form feathery masses of all male or all female flowers.

Asarum canadense (Wild Ginger) ☼○☺ϝ

COLOR: Maroon-brown (beneath foliage) HEIGHT: 6-12"
BLOOM: Late Spring/Early Summer SOIL: Well drained, acidic
COMMENTS: This deciduous perennial groundcover has unique velvety green, heart-shaped leaves and is a great addition to the spring woodland garden. Roots have similar scent to culinary ginger, but not related.

Asclepias incarnata - traditional & 'Ice Ballet' (Swamp Milkweed) ☼○☺βϝ

COLOR: Bright purple HEIGHT: 3-4'
BLOOM: June - July SOIL: Moist
COMMENTS: Willow-like leaves. A great insect plant - a butterfly magnet, as with all milkweeds.

Asclepias tuberosa (Butterfly Weed) ☼☺βγχ

COLOR: Bright orange HEIGHT: 24"
BLOOM: July - August SOIL: Well-drained sandy or gravelly soil
COMMENTS: Blooms followed in autumn by canoe-shaped seed pods that send forth silky seeds; good for cut flower; pods good for arrangements.

Asclepias verticillata (Whorled Milkweed) ☼*○☺❖⌘βγχ

COLOR: Greenish-white HEIGHT: 1-3'
BLOOM: Summer SOIL: Dry
COMMENTS: Narrow, linear leaves are whorled along the stem. Small, greenish-white flowers occur in flat-topped clusters on the upper part of the stem.

Asclepias syriaca (Common Milkweed) ☼☺βγ

COLOR: Deep pink HEIGHT: 2-5'
BLOOM: June - July SOIL: Well-drained
COMMENTS: Best known as food for monarch caterpillars. Robust and fragrant.

Aster cordifolius 'Avondale' (Blue Wood Aster) *○βγ

COLOR: Blue HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: Early fall SOIL: Average to dry
COMMENTS: Good for planting under trees, at the edge of woods or among Hostas and Astilbes, which look pretty rough by September.

Aster novae-angliae—"Purple Dome" (New England Aster) ☼○☺βγ

COLOR: Deep purple HEIGHT: 18"
BLOOM: Early Fall SOIL: Moist to average
COMMENTS: Compact variety that provides a burst of vivid deep purple color

Aster oblongifolius 'Raydon's Favorite' (Aromatic Aster) ☼○βγχ

COLOR: Medium Blue HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: September - October SOIL: Average, dry
COMMENTS: Has a showy, strikingly beautiful mounded appearance with masses of violet-blue, daisy-like flowers. This fragrant flower is a preferred nectar source for many butterfly species.

Baptisia australis (Blue Wild Indigo/Blue False Indigo) ☼○β⌘χ


COLOR: Indigo blue HEIGHT: 3-4'
BLOOM: Late spring-early summer SOIL: Dry to average, well-drained soil
COMMENTS: Upright perennial which features purple, lupine-like flowers. Stems with seed pods are valued additions to dried flower arrangements.

Caltha palustris (Marsh Marigold) ☼○☺γ

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: 8-12"
BLOOM: March-May SOIL: Moist to wet
COMMENTS: Shiny green, round foliage, one of the first wildflowers to bloom in early spring.

Chelone obliqua 'Tiny Tortuga' (Turtlehead) ☼○βγ

COLOR: Deep pink
HEIGHT: 18-24"
BLOOM: Late summer
SOIL: Moist, average
COMMENTS: Tiny with all the flower power of its taller brothers, this native cultivar features uniquely shaped, hot pink flowers reminiscent of turtles' mouths atop lustrous dark green leaves. A favorite of butterflies.

Chelone glabra (Turtlehead) ☼○☺γ

COLOR: White
HEIGHT: 2-4'
BLOOM: August - September
SOIL: Slightly acid moist soil
COMMENTS: Native; lustrous, deep green foliage; upright perennial; flowers in small clusters on stems; pinch shoot tips in Spring for bushier growth.

Coreopsis auriculata 'Jethro Tull', 'Red Satin', 'Crème Brulee' ☼○βγχ

COLOR: Jethro Tull and Crème Brulee are yellow. Red Satin is ruby red
HEIGHT: 15-18"
BLOOM: Spring through Summer
SOIL: Average to dry, well drained
COMMENTS: Responds beautifully to cutting back.

Dicentra spectabilis (Asian Bleeding Heart) ☼○γ

COLOR: Pink or white
HEIGHT: 30"
BLOOM: May - June
SOIL: Well-drained soil, humus-rich
COMMENTS: Pink and white heart-shaped flowers hang off a long arching stem; goes dormant in summer.

Echinacea - 'Cheyenne Spirit' (Coneflower) ☼○βγχ

COLOR: Mixed colors (see comments)
HEIGHT: 24-30"
BLOOM: July - August
SOIL: Average to dry soil
COMMENTS: This plant flowers in a variety of colors from purple, pink, red and orange tones to lighter yellows, creams and whites.

Echinacea purpurea 'Green Twister' (Cone Flower) ☼○βγ

COLOR: Red center with green edges
HEIGHT: 2 - 3'
BLOOM: July - August
SOIL: Average to dry
COMMENTS: Great for pollinators. New color variety!

Echinacea paradoxa (Coneflower) ☼○βγ

COLOR: Assorted
HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: July - August
SOIL: Average to dry soil
COMMENTS: Heat & drought tolerant; long flowering season; full sun/part shade; will self-sow where happy

Echinacea purpurea - 'Ruby Star' (Purple coneflower) ☼○⌘βγχ

COLOR: Deep purple-pink, almost ruby
HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: July - August
SOIL: Average to dry soil
COMMENTS: Heat & drought tolerant; long flowering season; full sun/part shade; will self-sow where happy

Key

Eupatorium coelestinum (Wild Ageratum/Mistflower) ☀️🌞🌱

(also synonymous with *Conoclinium coelestinum*)

COLOR: Bright Blue HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: Late summer SOIL: Average
COMMENTS: Cut back in early summer for denser, more upright growth.

Eupatorium dubium 'Little Joe' (3-nerved Joe Pye Weed) 🌞🌱🌿

COLOR: Pink-lavender HEIGHT: 4-5'
BLOOM: July - September SOIL: Moist, acidic
COMMENTS: Shorter than most other Joe Pye Weeds.

Geranium maculatum (Wild Geranium) 🌞☀️🌱

COLOR: Violet-rose HEIGHT: 15-24"
BLOOM: May - June SOIL: Average to moist, humus
COMMENTS: Airy clusters of flowers above height foliage; nice slow creeper.

Geum fragarioides (Appalachian Barren Strawberry) ☀️🌱🌿

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: 3-6"
BLOOM: Late spring/early summer SOIL: Average well drained
COMMENTS: Hardy, semi-evergreen groundcover with strawberry-like dark green foliage and delightful yellow flowers. Fruit is small and inedible.

Helenium autumnale 'Mardi Gras' (Sneezeweed) 🌞🌿

COLOR: Yellow edged with bright orange-red HEIGHT: 36-40"
BLOOM: Late June -early August SOIL: Moist, Well-drained
COMMENTS: Bright tie-dyed flowers are a natural rabbit repellent

Heliopsis helianthoides, variety scabra 'Burning Hearts' (False Sunflower) 🌞🌱🌿

COLOR: Red, yellow HEIGHT: 3 - 4'
BLOOM: Late summer SOIL: Moist or dry
COMMENTS: "Burning Hearts" is a show-stopping color that is also attractive to bees and butterflies

Iris cristata 'Powder Blue Giant' (Dwarf Crested Iris) ☀️🌱

COLOR: Blue HEIGHT: 6-8"
BLOOM: Late spring/early summer SOIL: Rich, moist, well-drained
COMMENTS: Considerably huskier and more vigorous than others of the species, this sweet giant boasts 3" flowers of delicate light blue with golden crests and deep blue accents.

Iris versicolor (Blue Flag) 🌞🌱

COLOR: Blue HEIGHT: 3'
BLOOM: May & June SOIL: Moist.
COMMENTS: Native wetland plant. Moist location essential.

Liatris spicata (Blazing Star) 🌞🌱🌿

COLOR: Lavender spikes HEIGHT: 3-5'
BLOOM: July - August SOIL: Average, moist.
COMMENTS: Excellent cut flower. Adaptable to sites with poor soil. A butterfly magnet.

Tradescantia 'Sweet Kate' (Spiderwort) 🌞🌱

COLOR: Lavender HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: June - September SOIL: Moist to dry
COMMENTS: Easy to grow. Tolerates a wide range of conditions. Blooms primarily in the morning. Each flower blooms only once and then 'melts'.

Verbena hastata (Swamp Verbena/Vlue Vervain) 🌞🌿

COLOR: Violet HEIGHT: 4-6'
BLOOM: July-August SOIL: Moist, well drained
COMMENTS: Tall thin spikes of violet flowers. Prefers moist to average soil. Great plant for pond's edge.

Vernonia lettermanii (Iron Butterfly) 🌞🌿

COLOR: Purple HEIGHT: 30-36"
BLOOM: Late summer SOIL: Moist to average
COMMENTS: Attractive to butterflies. Though native of moist meadows, it is plenty tolerant of hot dry summers.

Vernonia noveboracensis (New York Ironweed) 🌞🌱

COLOR: Bright purple HEIGHT: 4-7'
BLOOM: August - September SOIL: Average to moist
COMMENTS: Lovely native that adapts well to any moist location.

Ferns

Matteuccia struthiopteris (Ostrich Fern) ☀️🌱🌿

HEIGHT: 3-5' SOIL: Well-drained, moist- neutral to acid
COMMENTS: Tolerates some sunshine. Large, plume-like, medium green fern. Grows in graceful vase-like clumps from a stout rootstock.. Very hardy. Spreads Quickly.

Vines

Gelsemium sempervirens 'Margarita' (Carolina Jessamine) 🌞🌱🌿

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: Vine 8-12'
BLOOM: early summer SOIL: Average
COMMENTS: Mostly evergreen leaves. Profusion of yellow trumpet flowers in early summer.

Lonicera sempervirens (Coral Honeysuckle & "Major Wheeler") 🌞🌱🌿

COLOR: Red HEIGHT: 3-6'
BLOOM: May - frost SOIL: Average
COMMENTS: A vine that is perfect for arbors and trellises. Hummingbird magnet.

Sanguinaria canadensis (Bloodroot) * ○ ☺

COLOR: White HEIGHT: 6-10'
 BLOOM: March-April S OIL: Moist, well drained.
 COMMENTS: Each flower stalk has one solitary flower. The sap of the plant is red, thus the name.

Scabiosa columbaria 'Butterfly Blue' (Pincushion Flower) ☼ β χ

COLOR: Sky blue or pink HEIGHT: 12-15"
 BLOOM: May - frost SOIL: Rich, well-drained
 COMMENTS: Excellent border plant. Butterfly magnet.

Sedum telphinum - 'Autumn Joy' 'Dazzleberry' (Stonecrop) ☼ β χ ♂

COLOR: Pink HEIGHT: 2-3'
 BLOOM: Late Summer SOIL: Average to dry, well-drained
 COMMENTS: Sedums love hot, dry conditions. Excellent as a perennial border, in rock gardens & as ground cover. Dazzleberry has raspberry pink flowers and Autumn Joy rosy pink

Sedum - 'Vera Jamison' (Stonecrop) ☼ β χ ♂

COLOR: Pink HEIGHT: 10-12"
 BLOOM: Fall SOIL: Average to dry, well-drained
 COMMENTS: Sedums love hot, dry conditions. Excellent as a perennial border, in rock gardens & xeriscaping.

Silene caroliniana 'Short & Sweet' (Wild Pink) ☼ ○ * β ☺

COLOR: Deep Pink HEIGHT: 6-8"
 BLOOM: Late spring /early summer SOIL: Average to rich, moist to dry
 COMMENTS: Delightful, compact and easy to grow, it is an excellent choice for bright shade or full sun. It is covered in deep pink flowers in late spring.

Solidago odora (Anise Scented Goldenrod/Sweet Goldenrod) ☼ ○ β χ ♂ ☼ ☺

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: 2-4'
 BLOOM: Late summer/fall SOIL: Well drained, moist to dry
 COMMENTS: Wonderfully fragrant leaves give off an anise scent when crushed, reminiscent of licorice candy. Attracts butterflies, bees, ladybugs, lacewings and other beneficial insects.

Solidago rugosa "Fireworks" (Goldenrod) ☼ ○ β χ

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: 3-4'
 BLOOM: Late Summer SOIL: Moist, well-drained
 COMMENTS: Striking, clump-forming perennial with stiff lateral electric-yellow flowers that are reminiscent of exploding fireworks. Fireworks wrinkle-leaf goldenrod attracts many pollinating insects when flowering.

Stylophorum diphyllum (Celandine Poppy/Wood Poppy) * ❖

COLOR: Golden yellow HEIGHT: 12-24"
 BLOOM: Spring SOIL: Moist to moderately damp
 COMMENTS: Easy to grow native that will self-sow and form a ground cover.

Thalictrum rochebrunianum (Giant Meadowrue) ☼ ○ ♂

COLOR: lavender HEIGHT: 4-6'
 BLOOM: July & August SOIL: Average to moist
 COMMENTS: Deep wine purple stems are topped with broad umbels of bright, lavender clusters.

Lobelia cardinalis (Cardinal Flower) * ○ ☺ ☼

COLOR: Scarlet red HEIGHT: 32"
 BLOOM: July - September SOIL: Very moist
 COMMENTS: A spike of flowers; vigorous; will self-seed. This plant is pollinated exclusively by hummingbirds.

Lobelia siphilitica (Great Blue Lobelia) ☼ ○ ☺ β ☼

COLOR: Blue HEIGHT: 30"
 BLOOM: July - September SOIL: Moist
 COMMENTS: Vigorous; will self-seed.

Meehan cordata (Meehan's Mint, or Creeping Mint) * ○ ♂ ☼ ☺

COLOR: Blue Violet HEIGHT: 12"
 BLOOM: Late Spring-Early Summer SOIL: Moist to average
 COMMENTS: Long, trailing stems run across the ground and root along the way. In late spring the green carpet gives way to hundreds of blue flowers opening to reveal spotted throats.

Mertensia virginica (Virginia Bluebells) * ○ ☺

COLOR: blue HEIGHT: 20"
 BLOOM: April - May SOIL: Rich, moist soil
 COMMENTS: New flowers look pink but open blue. Strong clump-forming plant; goes dormant after blooming.

Monarda didyma - 'Jacob Cline' (Bee Balm) ☼ ○ ☺ β ☼ ♂

COLOR: Rich red HEIGHT: 30"
 BLOOM: June - July SOIL: Moist, rich soil
 COMMENTS: Fragrant aromatic foliage; numerous tubular flowers extend out of a ball-shaped whorl; vigorous growth habits; much more mildew resistant and larger flowered; good cut flower.

Monarda 'Petite Delight' (Beebalm) ☼ ○ β ☼ χ ♂

COLOR: Lavender-Pink HEIGHT: 12"
 BLOOM: July-August SOIL: Well drained moist
 COMMENTS: More compact than others in the species. Very low maintenance. Cherished by butterflies and hummingbirds, but loathed by deer. Also makes an excellent cut flower.

Oenothera fruticosa 'Fireworks' (Sundrops/Narrowleaf Evening Primrose) ☼ β ♂ ☺

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: 15-18"
 BLOOM: Late spring-early summer SOIL: Well drained
 COMMENTS: Day-flowering member of the evening primrose family and produces terminal clusters of bright yellow four-petal flowers.

Packera aurea, formerly Senecio aureus (Golden Ragwort) ☀️🌱🌞🐇

COLOR: Bright golden HEIGHT: 12"
BLOOM: May SOIL: Average to moist
COMMENTS: Prefers partial shade. A strong ground cover where happy.

Penstemon digitalis (Beardtongue) ☀️🐇β⋈

COLOR: White HEIGHT: 12-18"
BLOOM: Late Spring - Early Summer SOIL: Well drained
COMMENTS: This native makes a stunning display with its brilliant white flowers against a backdrop of deep red foliage. Tough and easy to grow, it tolerates a wide variety of conditions including hot, dry sites.

Phlox divaricata - 'Blue Moon' (Wild Blue Phlox) 🌱🌞🌞β

COLOR: Pale blue HEIGHT: 8-10"
BLOOM: April - May SOIL: Rich
COMMENTS: Perfect for shady gardens, wooded areas.

Phlox paniculata - 'Jeana' & 'Robert Poore' (Summer Phlox) ☀️🌞β⋈

COLOR: Pink HEIGHT: 4-5'
BLOOM: June - October SOIL: Average, well drained
COMMENTS: 'Jeana' produces fragrant tubular lavender-pink florets (to 1/2" diameter) densely packed in large-tiered terminal clusters and 'Robert Poore' richly colored red-purple.

Phlox Stolonifera 'Home Fires' (Creeping Phlox) 🌱🌞β⋈❖

COLOR: Pink HEIGHT: 6-10"
BLOOM: Late spring/early summer SOIL: Average, well drained
COMMENTS: Mat-forming highly fragrant with masses of large, deep pink flowers. A beautifully vibrant groundcover that will bring excitement to the shady or woodland garden.

Podophyllum peltatum (May Apple) 🌱🌞🌞

COLOR: White HEIGHT: 12-18"
BLOOM: March-May SOIL: Moist, well-drained
COMMENTS: Nice addition to a shade or woodland garden.

Polygonatum falcatum (Variegated Solomon's Seal) 🌱🌞

COLOR: White HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: April-May SOIL: Moist, Well-drained
COMMENTS: Woodland Garden plant with dark green leaves edged in white. White bell-shaped flowers emerge from beneath the stem.

Physostegia virginiana 'Miss Manners' (Obedience Plant) ☀️🌞⋈

COLOR: Orchid pink or white HEIGHT: 18-24"
BLOOM: June to October SOIL: Average
COMMENTS: Snapdragon-like spikes. Good cut flower.

Pycnanthemum muticum (Short-Toothed Mountain Mint) ☀️🌞🐇β⋈❖🌞

COLOR: White HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: Late Summer SOIL: Well-drained
COMMENTS: Very attractive to beneficial garden insects such as bees & butterflies. Mountain Mint is loaded with pulegone, the same insect repellent found in pennyroyal. It can be rubbed on the skin to repel mosquitoes!

Ratibida columnifera 'Red Midget' (Mexican Hat Plant) ☀️🌞β⋈

COLOR: Red/Orange HEIGHT: 18-36"
BLOOM: Late Summer/Fall SOIL: Well-drained
COMMENTS: Fun, unique flowers dance above mounds of fine green foliage from June until frost. A native prairie plant, this dwarf variety of the species performs exceptionally well in hot and dry conditions.

Rudbeckia fulgida 'Goldstrum' (Black-eyed Susan 'Goldstrum') ☀️🌞🌞β⋈

COLOR: Bright gold HEIGHT: 24-30"
BLOOM: July-Oct. SOIL: Average to dry
COMMENTS: Long flowering period.

Rudbeckia subtomentosa 'Henry Eilers' (Sweet Black-eyed Susan) ☀️🌞β⋈⋈

COLOR: Yellow HEIGHT: 4-5'
BLOOM: Late Summer SOIL: Average, moist
COMMENTS: 'Henry Eilers' has finely quilled flowers of true yellow, not gold, and is stunning in a mass planting.

Ruellia humilis (Fringed-leaf Petunia) ☀️🌞❖⋈⋈

COLOR: Pink to purple HEIGHT: 2-3'
BLOOM: All summer SOIL: Dry, basic.
COMMENTS: Long flowering period. Drought tolerant.

Salvia lyrata 'Purple Knockout' (Lyre-Leaf Sage) ☀️🌞⋈β⋈🌞

COLOR: Light blue HEIGHT: 18"
BLOOM: Late Spring-Early Summer SOIL: Average to moist
COMMENTS: Drought and humidity tolerant.
