

Fees for Programs

Badges: \$66.00 for up to 15 scouts. Additional scouts for \$4.50 each. No charge for parents, siblings and leaders

Sleepovers: \$200.00 for up to 15 scouts. \$10.00 each additional girl. Chaperones free.

Campfire programs: \$90.00 for up to 18 participants. \$5.00 each additional person.

- *Must have 1 adult chaperone for every 4 girls.
- * Fees in this brochure are effective* until 12/31/18.
