Minimum fee: \$200 for 15 Scouts – \$10.00 for each additional scout, with a maximum of 36. There must be 1 adult chaperone for every 4 scouts. Chaperones are free. Additional badges are \$66.00 for each additional 1 ½ hour program requested.
