

# \* FAQs \*

## What do I need to bring?

Appropriate clothes for the weather and a flashlight/headlamp for the nighttime programs.

For the campfires, note that we provide only the marshmallows and skewers. Bring the rest of the supplies if you wish to make s'mores!

## What if it rains?

If the weather is too inclement for the group to go outdoors, you may reschedule or choose to have the program indoors. Our indoor wood stove is great for roasting marshmallows.

## How many badges can I do?

Many scout troops complete 2 badges per sleepover (one in the evening and one in the morning. See fees section.) For daytime badge journeys, we can do up to 3 badges in one day.

## How do I book?

Call or email Stephanie Catrambone (sacatrambone@buckscounty.org; 267-880-5037) at least 3 weeks before the date you wish to book. Campfires and Sleepovers are held on Friday & Saturday evenings. Badge Journeys can be held any time during our office hours.

# Fees

**Badges:** \$66 for up to 15 scouts. Additional scouts are \$4.50 each.

**Sleepovers:** \$200.00 for up to 15 scouts. Additional scouts are \$10 each.

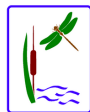
**Campfire Programs:** \$90.00 for up to 18 scouts. Additional scouts are \$5 each.

## Cancellation Fee

A \$10 cancellation fee will be charged if you cancel your reservation.

- No charge for parents, siblings, or leaders.
- You can add on multiple badges for \$66 per badge program
- Must have 1 adult chaperone for every 4 boys.
- Fees are due 2 weeks after the reservation is made.
- If your group size changes, the nature center must be notified by 3pm the business day before your scheduled program.
